

## Survey of Favorite Music

### Background

On Dec. 16, 2004, Lawton record collector Bill Cunningham presented a Lunch Bag Lecture on the topic “The Basics of Collecting Recorded Music: Why I like Chopin, Dave Brubeck, Muddy Waters, Bob Wills and the Grateful Dead.” The audience was invited to complete a survey of their favorite records, and Cunningham then extended this opportunity to a diversity of others around the country.

The object of the survey was to cause each respondent to appreciate his or her own record collection and to seek the answer to the eternal question, “What is good music?” About twenty-five persons took the time to list their favorite records and other information. Most provided both artist and album/CD title, while some provided only artist or song. The input was sorted into the broadest of genres, recognizing that some categories contain wide diversity and juxtapositions.

Such as it is, this represents the collections of music recording that these people would take with them to a desert island. Depending on your taste in music, this list represents what others like you may recommend that you spend your money on.
